PERFORMANCE WEAR & LEOTARDS

Q: What can members wear for competitions?

A: For Champion Girl/Lady and teams all members of all ages can wear either:

- ✓ A leotard
- ✓ Leggings over a leotard
- ✓ Performance wear.

Q: Who is supplying what?

A: As it is no longer financially viable for Danz Design to manufacture leotards due to the low quantities being purchased, BJP is supplying performance wear and leotards for teams and Champion Girl in 2023.

Q: Is there a long sleeve top option this year?

A: Yes, the new Grande top has long sleeves, a boat neck and thin criss-cross straps at the back. Pictures will be added to the online catalogue as soon as production is finished.

Q: Can garments from previous years from 'swaps and sales' be worn in competitions?

A: Yes, leotards and performance wear from any previous years may be worn, provided the garment style is not altered and the logo is still in place.

LEOTARDS

Q: What will leotards cost?

A: Leotards will be \$65 and are all fully lined.

Q: How many styles will there be?

A: At this stage we are producing one style of sleeveless leotard, similar to the Aspen, and will gauge further production based on sales. Pictures will be added to the online catalogue as soon as production is finished.

Q: How many colours will there be?

A: The leotard will be available in the same range of plain colours as the Performance Wear. The black and white leotards have a matching mesh panel across the front neckline. Other colours have no mesh.

PERFORMANCE WEAR

Q: What will performance wear cost to buy?

A: Prices are staying the same in 2023. Leggings \$65. Tops \$60. Tank tops \$40. New Crop Tops \$40. Old-style crop tops are now discounted to \$30.

Q: Does it cost extra to have tops lined?

A: No. All tops and crop tops come fully lined (except the loose tank top).

Q: What sizes will there be?

A: Sizes child 4 to adult 24. Larger sizes can be specially made on request. There is a new size for leggings that is in between child and adult sizes. It's called "Ladies 4/Child 14".

Q: What fabrics are currently in the Physie Shop and what is coming soon?

A:

- 19 plain colours. Lime recently added. Coral is coming soon.
- 7 prints - 4 existing and 3 new prints coming soon.
- Black and white honeycomb mesh.
- Shimmer (white), Sleek (black) and new Red Bling coming soon.

Q: Will there be different collections released through the year?

A: No. The shop will always be stocked with something for you to buy and, from time to time, a new fabric will be added when production is finished. We don't have any release dates for new colours, prints or fabrics yet.

Q: Will every colour and print always be restocked?

A: No. Any prints or colours that are not popular may be discontinued when sold out.

Q: Can I wear a crop top and leggings?

A: Only if you wear another mesh or plain top over it.

Q: Can I adjust the length of the tops and leggings?

A: Tops and leggings can be taken up a little if they are too long but only to the height of the BJP logo, which must always be visible in order to wear the garment in competitions.

Q: What is the fabric?

A: 80% polyester 20% spandex

PERFORMANCE WEAR DELIVERY AND EXCHANGE

Q: How are my garments delivered?

A: Orders will be processed and despatched within 48 hours via Australia Post.

Q: Do you process orders on weekends?

A: No, only Monday to Friday.

Q: How long will delivery take?

A: The length of delivery time is dependent upon Australia Post.

Q: Can I get Express Post?

A: Yes.

Q: Can I exchange performance wear if it doesn't fit or I don't like it?

A: Yes. However, whatever the reason for your exchange, there are strict conditions so please read the terms and conditions carefully. Do not remove any tags, wear or wash any garment if you wish to exchange it.

Q: Where do any profits from performance wear sales go?

A: Our aim is not to make a profit, our aim is to keep the prices to members as low as possible. Since we are a non-profit organisation, by law any profit that we make must always be reinvested in the sport for the benefit of the members. We have no shareholders, and nobody can make any financial gain from the business. Our entire purpose is and will always be to grow and improve Physie in Australia and to secure the future of the sport for the next generation.
